NIEPA Internal Review Committee to Consider the Cases for Grant of Career Advancement Scheme (CAS) to Eligible Faculty Members¹

The Committee met on 9th, 10th, 11th and 14th December 2020 to discuss the norms for assessing the category-wise required API scores and other related requirements for CAS on the basis of the related norms developed and approved by NIEPA and the UGC Regulation, 2010.

The agenda of the meetings were as follows:

- (i) To look into the ACRs of the CAS applicants;
- (ii) To develop the framework for reviewing the API scores of the CAS applicants on the basis of NIEPA norms and the UGC Regulation, 2010; and
- (iii) To recommend the publications submitted by the CAS applicants for external review.

The Committee looked into the NIEPA norms for calculating the API scores, and the related norms and criteria laid down in the UGC Regulation, 2010.

- 1. After detailed deliberations, the Committee developed a Format for Reviewing the API Scores of CAS Applications, which is attached as Document I. Document I has been developed on the basis of Document II, which contains the API norms duly approved by the Competent authority of NIEPA and the UGC Regulation, 2010.
- 2. Document I (i.e., Format for Reviewing the API Scores of CAS Applications), if approved would be used for reviewing the CAS applications.
