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Workshop on Improving Participation of Children in Elementary Schools

Background

In recent years, India has witnessed considerable improvement in access and enrolment in school as a result of various initiatives like, the DPEP and SSA. The RTE Act, 2009 has not only stressed on access to free and compulsory education for 6-14 years old children, it has also focused on regular participation and learning of children. However, many studies indicate that effective management of school can improve the quality of school functioning that in turn influences the participation of children and finally improving retention, promotion, completion as well as learning achievement of children. Although there are many evidences suggesting improvement in; schooling facilities, provision of mid-day meals, enrolment rates and consequent reduction of social and gender gaps, especially in enrollment, several problems still remain unresolved which include frequent and long absenteeism of children, heavy dropout before completion of the elementary cycle and extremely poor learning levels of children.

Most often it is found that many schools, particularly located in rural areas, are devoid of attractive child friendly school environment that discourages children to attend school regularly. Physical infrastructure is still far from sufficient in many of the rural schools. There is inadequacy of better qualified teachers who show care and affection towards children and encourage them to learn. There are fewer motivated teachers who would like to teach in remote rural schools. Transfer of teachers is a controversial issue across the states. Therefore, with low levels of teaching activity in many schools, quality of learning achievement remains a serious concern. It is understandable that this situation certainly results in denying children adequate learning opportunities and finally adversely effecting their learning achievement. It has been felt that, in addition to focusing on physical access of poor and disadvantaged children to schools, strategic intervention is required to ensure their regular and meaningful participation that would in turn result in improvement in learning for all children, irrespective of their social identity and economic background. The problems related to low achievement requires special attention of administrators working particularly at sub-district and school level.

With this background this workshop intends to focus on efficient management of schools for improving participation of children covering the issues related to absenteeism, repetition, low transition, high dropout and abysmally poor learning achievement. It is expected that this discussion would help in working out an action plan to ensure effective school participation of children. Following objectives are set before the workshop.

Objectives:

- i) To familiarize participants with the situation of participation with special focus on absenteeism, repetition, transition and drop out in elementary education cycle using the data collected for recent researches;
- ii) To understand the issues like, long absenteeism, repetition and poor learning level, dropout and their linkages with the help of appropriate case studies of children who are not showing participation as expected;
- iii) To evolve an understanding about effective ways of managing participation of children at various levels of educational administration including local level and school level;
- iv) To prepare an action plan for improvement of school participation of children.

Participants/Target Groups: Block Education Officers, Cluster Resource Centre Coordinators, selected School Principals from Chhattisgarh, Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh (List in Annexure IV) will be participating in this workshop.

Session Details:

Introduction:

This session will be devoted for introducing participants to each other

Participation in Elementary Education: The Context of RTE Act:

This session will introduce participants with issues regarding access and participation in India and drawing reference from various documents and researches as well as secondary data this session will provide an overview of present situation regarding access and participation of children in elementary schools and will explain challenges for each representative block and school to achieve the goal of effective implementation of RTE Act, 2009. The session may also include a brief discussion on expansion of RTE to pre-primary and secondary level.

Programme Details: This session will also introduce the programme and different sessions, setting the objectives of programme and explaining tasks for achieving the objectives

Participation of Students in Elementary Schools: Research Findings

This session will provide detailed overview on status of school participation encompassing access, enrolment, attendance, retention and learning level of children. The data collected from the field (CREATE and SHASE) will be used for this discussion.

Inside Schools and Classrooms: Situation in Different Places

In This session an effort will be made to make participants aware about the situation prevailing in schools in different study areas, photographs, people's opinion and teachers' and head teachers' opinion will be presented before participants.

School Participation in States/ Districts: Present Status: Sharing of Participants' Views

These sessions will include presentation of participants from MP, Chhattisgarh and Rajasthan followed by discussion of participants. It will also include **Group Work** for identifying emerging issues from presentations of three states.

Problem of Absenteeism at the school level: Research Findings:

This session will discuss important issues regarding absenteeism of students and its impact on their learning Outcomes.

Case Studies of Schools and Children

This session will be devoted to provide understanding about linkage between school functioning and participation behaviour of children. This will include discussion on cases of four schools and some children who have already been excluded

Determining Factors of Learning Outcome of Children

This session will include discussion on school wise learning level of children and how it is linked with home factors like income, occupation, education and aspiration of parents and whether these determine children's learning level. Similarly, it will also discuss school related factors like teachers' availability, qualification, training, experiences, multi-grade teaching etc.

Participation or Exclusion? Focus on Children Affected by Migration and Mobility

This session will discuss whether internal mobility in terms of school transfer and outmigration of parents and children have any impact on schooling of children. How local administrators and school heads can ensure school participation of children after they get affected by migration and school transfer.

Students Absenteeism in Urban Context

Findings of an ongoing study will be shared in this session that would make participants aware about local initiatives that are required to deal with the problem of absenteeism in government schools in the urban areas.

School Governance and participation of Children: Crucial Issues

School governance, definition and present situation, evidences from research, challenges. School governance at block and local level, internal management of school
