



Training Programme in Planning and Management of Higher Education Finances (November 11-15, 2013)

Background

Financing of higher education has become a problem not only in India but also in developed/developing countries as a whole. The higher education sector gets low priority as compared to other levels of education. So better planning and efficient management of finances is essential to improve the situation in the field of higher education.

Objectives of the Programmes:

- To orient the participants to the existing system of financial planning and management of higher education across states and to facilitate its systematic financial review in the context of changing requirements of the financing of higher education system in India;
- To enable the participants to appreciate the role of financial planning and management in higher education;
- To facilitate the application oriented financial planning and management techniques in higher education in order to cope up with the changing demands

- Cost Analysis of Higher Educational Institutions
- Mobilisation of resources for universities - fees, donations and other sources
- Fee Determination Criteria in Colleges and Universities
- Utilisation of resources in Higher Education
- Accounting methods in Higher Educational Institutions
- Application of Financial Management Tools such as Time Value of Money, etc
- Developing Financial Management Indicators

Participants

Secretaries, Joint Secretaries, Directors, Joint Directors, Senior Officers from Directorate of Collegiate Education and Senior Officers dealing with finance and budgets of higher education in the Departments of Planning in the state/central governments.

Funding

NUEPA does not charge any fees for the programme. Travel assistance is provided to the participants. TA is restricted to **lowest Economy Air fare/ Apex fare by Air India** in the shortest route to the officers who are eligible for air travel. **Travel costs by other airlines will not be reimbursed.** Those officers who are not eligible for air travel, NUEPA will pay train fare as per rules. **TA will be paid only to those officers who attend all the five days of the orientation programme.**
