The programme was launched in 2014. The overall objective of the National Award Programme is to identify and recognise field level innovations in Educational Administration.

The major objectives of the Programme are:

- * To recognize innovations in educational administration at district and block level;
- * To award those who conceived and implemented the innovations; and
- * To document and disseminate innovations.

AREAS OF INNOVATIONS

The National Awards for Innovations covers different aspects of Educational Administration. Some of the identifiable areas of innovations in educational administration and management may include the following:

- * Improving access and participation
- * Improving quality of teaching-learning and students' academic achievement in government schools
- * Teacher management including teacher deployment, ensuring regularity and punctuality, professional development, teacher motivation etc.
- * Effective management of academic support mechanism
- * Promoting innovations in teaching-learning process
- * Institutional planning

- * Enhancing community participation in school management
- * Supervision and monitoring system
- * Distribution and management of Mid Day Meal and other incentive schemes

- * Education of Scheduled Tribes and Scheduled Castes Children
- * Administration and management of schools in difficult and left wing Maoist affected areas
- * Administration and management of schools in natural disaster stricken areas
- * Transparency and accountability in educational administration etc.
- * Use of ICT in educational administration and management
- * Creating public trust on government schools

The selected candidates for the national award will be presented a certificate and an amount of Rs. 10,000/- in the national award presentation function, organised by NUEPA in New Delhi. The award function will be preceded by a two day Conference on innovations in educational administration.
